**CHERIE MAE WALTER**  
**February 1, 1929 – October 29, 2016**

On February 1, 1929, in Winnipeg, Edgar and Frances Halsey welcomed a baby girl to their young family. Edgar had family roots going back to the earliest days of The Salvation Army, so it is natural that much of Cherie's life would be centered in the Army. Cherie had challenges from the day she was born, and these increased when her mother suddenly died in 1937, leading to Cherie and her brother Bruce living with grandparents and family until her father married Fairie Muttart in 1939 allowing the family to be reunited. Cherie met these early challenges with the tenacious spirit that would serve her well throughout her life. A little sister, Fairie, arrived in 1940 and together the Halsey children happily grew up as the children of Salvation Army officer parents in western Canada.

Cherie entered The Salvation Army College for Officers in 1949, graduated as a nurse in 1954 and married in 1956. Together with her husband, they lived in Ontario, Quebec, Pennsylvania and Madras, India. The major portion of Cherie's life was spent at Scarborough Citadel, where she started attending in 1965 with her family. She was active in all aspects of the Corps, but her most significant contribution was the leadership that she provided in the youth ministry where over many years of tireless service she touched the lives of scores of young people.

She always chose to be positive. Even in her final months she was grateful and considerate of others. With her unique sense of humour, she was loved by all who knew her. She was truly a Christ-like person.

Beloved wife of Vincent for more than sixty years and cherished mother of Bruce (Elizabeth) and Cheryl (Stephen) and predeceased by John (Kim). Treasured grandmother of Sarah (Mike), Hannah (Alex), Emma and Victoria; Michael (Meaghan), Andrew (Stephanie), Timothy (Danielle) and Stephanie; Erin, Stuart (Rebecca) and Nathan (Melanie). Much loved great-grandmother of Amelia, Sullivan and Huxley.
